- WHO CAN BE IN THE STUDY?
 - Children and adults diagnosed with Friedreich Ataxia.
- WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE STUDY?
 - The long-term goal of this study is to examine if measures of auditory, speech and vestibular abilities could be used as potential appropriate scale for future trials.
- WHAT ARE THE RESEARCH PROCEDURES?
 - Each test is a standard test used in everyday clinical practice to determine a patient's hearing, speech and vestibular abilities. The testing will last about 3 hours.
 - Tests are non-invasive procedures that resemble hearing and vestibular tests conducted at the Audiology Clinic.
